

South Shore Harbour Community Association Board of Directors' Informal Policy on Mail Center Corkboard Postings

Policy on Resident Use of Mail Center Corkboards

The purpose of this policy is to establish guidelines for resident use of the Corkboards above the community mailboxes at the South Shore Harbour Community Association (“SSH-CA”) U.S. Postal Mailbox Center.

Availability

The Corkboards above the SSH-CA community mailboxes are available for resident use on a non-exclusive, first-come, first-served, space available basis.

Use Restrictions and Responsibility

- Materials posted on these corkboards shall not contain vulgar, obscene, obnoxious, repulsive, offensive, or otherwise inappropriate content to SSH-CA members.
- Political, campaign, or election-related materials are prohibited.
- Individuals posting materials are solely responsible for obtaining any required consent before including personal information.
- Posted materials may not cover or obscure existing postings.
- All materials become the property of SSH-CA upon posting.
- SSH-CA will remove all materials on the last day of each month or shortly thereafter.
